

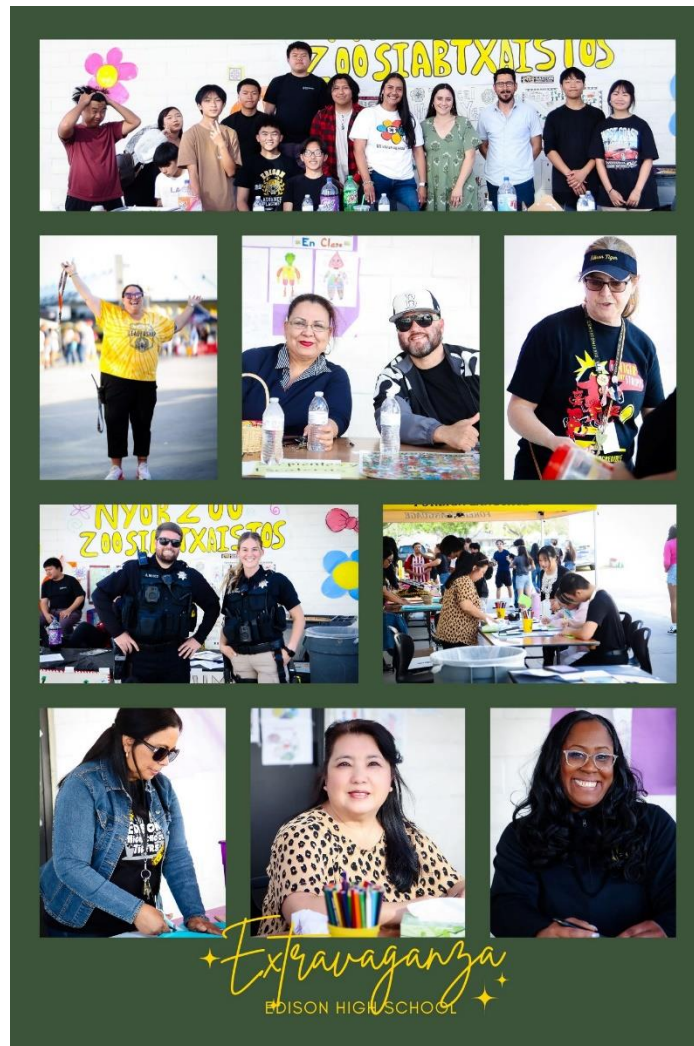

It is crucial that your children bring there fully charged laptops to school during TESTING.


Edison students must bring their charged laptops to class every period!!!
