Dress Code

As the weather warms up, our dress code policy will continue to be in effect. Students will NOT be allowed to wear red on campus. Morning Drop Off

Please continue to drop students off at one of the three pedestrian gates on California Ave. Remind your children that once students enter campus, they are to stay on campus until the end of the day.

Leaving Campus

Just a reminder that once a student leaves campus, they cannot and will not be allowed back on campus. For safety reasons, students should remain on campus, in their designated areas, until it is time for them to either attend their sport, attend after school program, or get on the bus.

Laptops

All students are expected to bring their charged laptop daily. Students can better engage and be supported in the learning if they bring a laptop to school every day. If your student is having issues with their laptop or needs a replacement, please visit the FLATS center located on the south side of Edison's south parking lot.

Detention

Lunch detention has begun. Detention is being assigned to students who have 6 or more tardies and/or behavior issues. Detention will be for 20 minutes in the gym directly after 4th period. They will have time after serving to get their lunch. There are NO Cell Phones allowed during detention. If a student is assigned lunch detention but does not show up, they will be put on the NO ADMIT list for school activities until they serve their days of detention, receive help from a teacher or tutor at lunch time and get it signed off (one time for each day assigned), or serve as a Campus helper.
