Free Fax Bus Fare for Students

Fresno Unified School District is now offering Fresno Area Express (FAX) bus passes to all high school and Fresno Adult School students that require transportation assistance. As a high school or Fresno Adult School student in our school district, your child can receive a free FAX bus pass through the district and its partnership with the Fresno Area Express (FAX). This program will allow students to ride the FAX city bus for free. Bus passes are valid for 31 days after the first day of activation and continued use must be requested by the student. Students are required to provide their valid Fresno Unified School District photo ID, along with their bus pass when boarding the bus. **Any high school or Fresno Adult School student attending a Fresno Unified School District school is eligible to receive a free bus pass unless their parent/guardian opts-out.** Please come to the North administration building before school, during break and lunch, or afterschool to sign out a pass.

Emergency Cards

If you did not fill out two yellow emergency cards in the beginning of the school year, please call the school, stop by, or have your student go to the attendance office to pick up blank cards. We would like to be able to contact you in case of an emergency.

Food Deliveries

Remember, students are **NOT ALLOWED** to receive food deliveries from food delivery services while they are on campus. Any student food deliveries will be turned away by office staff and students may be subjected to fees lost.

Site policies and consequences

Please remind your students of the following site policies and the consequences.

- Cellphone usage is a privilege and should be used appropriately or measures may be put in place to limit phone usage. (see board policy 5139)
- Violence on campus will not be tolerated and can lead to physical injury, suspension, expulsion, and arrest by law enforcement.

- Do not encourage or instigate a fight. You can be given disciplinary actions if it turns out that you were involved.
- Do not share video or pictures of a fight. The videos and pictures you take are considered evidence of a crime.
- Do not lie or interfere with an investigation.
- Students who run towards and record a fight may be considered a participant and may be subject to disciplinary actions.

We want to thank families for your support in this effort to build a more positive school community by talking to your students. Furthermore, if your student has information on a potential safety concern, please contact Edison school staff as soon as possible.

Dress code is being enforced. The responsibility for the dress and appearance of a student rests primarily with the student and their parents or guardians. Please make sure students are arriving to school in dress code. Examples of inappropriate clothing include:

- any single clothing item that is more than 50% Red or Dodger Blue (includes all accessories: shoes, backpacks, etc.)
- headwear that is not Edison headwear or a plain school color without logos or symbols (black, gold, grey, white, yellow)
- clothing where the torso is exposed, i.e., tube tops, half shirts, halters
- clothing that is see-through. (clothing must be opaque)
- clothing or accessories which show profanity, drug/alcohol, weapons, obscene words or pictures, sexually suggestive statements, or incites to violence
- clothing representing gang-related activities
- clothing where undergarments are exposed
- clothing that has text that is libelous, bullying, constitutes harassment or discrimination
- footwear must be worn at school and all functions

A student who violates the Dress and Appearance Policy shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action. Examples of disciplinary action may include but are not limited to a warning, lunch detention, parent conference, etc., depending on the level and/or frequency.

School Messenger Communication

School communication will be sent weekly through the school messenger program by email and text. The weekly communication is uploaded on the website <https://edison.fresnounified.org/> and posted on social media on Edison's Facebook at facebook.com/EHSTigers & on Twitter @Edison_The_540. It's critical that we have current phone numbers and email addresses from families, so you stay informed of events and activities happening at school.

Edison is now using a communication platform called **ParentSquare**. This will allow us to efficiently send out mass information to families. The app will also allow for two-way communication between you and the teacher. You should have received communication on how to register for **ParentSquare**. Please make sure that your personal information is updated in Atlas.

Safety

Parents, please talk to your student about the importance of thinking before you post. Posting inappropriate content can bring severe consequences such as suspension and in some cases expulsions. Social media should be monitored and used responsibly. Thanks for helping us keep students safe and teach responsible social media etiquette.

Edison has begun using a new visitor management system called Raptor. This system adds another layer of safety for all students, staff, and visitors. When visiting Edison's campus during regular business hours, please be prepared to show a driver's license or government-issued ID upon entering the office. With this and other safety issues that have been happening in our country, we will be requiring that students bring their IDs to campus daily. This may be a physical or digital form ID. Remember, **students are not allowed to receive food deliveries from food delivery services while they are on campus.** Any student food deliveries will be turned away by office staff and students may be subjected to fees lost.

COVID-19 Information

- Masks are allowed to be worn at the choice of each student and staff member. Masks are available upon request for all students and staff at their school site.
- Parents will be asked to monitor their students for symptoms while the student continues going to school in-person. Parents can also opt-in to have their student(s) COVID tested at school during their weekly scheduled testing times by completing the consent form at this link <https://my.primary.health/1/fresno-usd>.
- All students with symptoms of illness should stay home until symptoms have resolved and student no longer needs to take fever-reducing medication.
- If a student tests positive for COVID-19, they must isolate at home for at least 5 days. If on day 5 or later the student provides proof of a negative at-home COVID test, they can return to school on day 6. If they are still positive or have not taken another COVID-19 test, they must isolate for a full 10 days and can return to school on day 11.
- Close contacts do not need to quarantine. Only those with symptoms or who have tested positive for COVID-19 are required to stay home.
